Title: Admission for Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International program) *
TCAS Round 1 Portfolio Application, Non-written Examination
Academic year 2021

The International College of Dentistry Walailak University welcomes eligible applicants to apply for the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program). The details of the TCAS Round 1 Acceptance with Portfolio for Academic Year 2021 from August 20, 2020 until January 24, 2021 are as follows:

1. Form of admission selection method and selection criteria

Applicants must apply online at the admissions website <https://entry.wu.ac.th> from August 20, 2020 until January 24, 2021. Applicants must meet the selection methods and selection criteria of the admission examination committee for the Doctor of Dental Surgery program (International Program) International College of Dentistry Walailak University.

2. Qualifications of applicants

2.1. General qualifications

- 2.1.1. Able to communicate in Thai
- 2.1.2. Applicant must be responsible and honest as demonstrated in the interview.
- 2.1.3. Thai applicants must have the qualifications to work in government agencies after graduation and must be able to enter into a unilateral or open-ended contract with the government following the regulations and conditions of the government and the university.

2.2. Acceptance criteria

Educational qualifications for applicants must have one of the following:

- 2.2.1. Studying at a high school level (Grade 6) or equivalent in science-mathematic and must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) from Mathayom 4 to Mathayom 5 (4 semesters) of at least 3.25

OR

2.2.2. Graduates with a high school education (Grade 6) or equivalent in science-mathematic only and must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) from Mathayom 4 to Mathayom 6 not less than 3.25

OR

2.2.3. is a graduate of an international school in Thailand or currently studying in an international school in Thailand, equivalent to the grade of Mathayom 6

OR

2.2.4. Graduates from secondary school abroad or currently studying in a secondary school in a foreign country, equivalent to the level of Mathayom 6 (according to the announcement of the Ministry of Education regarding foreign qualification) or a certificate of knowledge matching the university. Applicants must present original evidence on the day of interview and physical examination.

Applicants studying or graduating from an international school in the country or a secondary school abroad must present results of one of the following examinations:

1) Test results (International) General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE / GCSE) specifying test scores in 3 subjects: Biology Chemistry and Mathematics or Physics and the results of the CE "AS" or GCE "A."

OR

2) International Baccalaureate (IB) Standard Level or Predicted IB score with Chemistry, Biology and Physics in group IV or Mathematics in group V.

OR

3) SAT II test results in Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics or Physics.

OR

4) Test scores from Sciences and Mathematics from abroad at the level of which is equivalent to high school grade 12. Acceptance of these scores will depend on the decision of selection committee.

5) Official BMAT score (if available)

We reserve the right not to accept applicants who have successfully completed the General Educational Development (GED) course.

2.3 English proficiency test scores

Applicants must have cumulative scores in English subjects from Mathayom 4 through Secondary School (6th year).

The total cumulative grade point average **must not be less than 3.5** or have one of the following English language test results:

1. TOEFL (PBT / ITP) not less than 498 points
2. TOEFL (CBT) not less than 171 points.
3. TOEFL (IBT) not less than 60 points.
4. TOEIC not less than 570 points.
5. IELTS not less than 6 points.
6. CU-TEP not less than 80 points
7. WU-TEP not less than 73.5 points
8. CEFR level not less than B2 score

2.4 Selection of participants by interviewing through the ZOOM program

2.5 Specific qualifications for those who are eligible to apply for the entrance examination

The specific eligibility requirements for the applicants to study are based on 3 important principles: 1) Do no harm to patients, 2) Do no harm to oneself, and do not cause harm to others and 3) must be in good health, without disease, symptoms, or disabilities that impede academic performance. These requirements are as follows:

2.5.1 Severe psychiatric disorders which may cause harm to self and/or to others or other psychiatric disorders that impede the dental practice.

2.5.2 Contagious diseases that might cause harm to self-and/or to others and may cause permanent disability which may become an impede the academic performance and dental practice.

2.5.3 Non-communicable diseases or conditions that hinder study and practice of dentistry including

2.5.3.1 Uncontrolled epilepsy (epileptic patients must have at least 3 years episode-free and certified by a medical expert)

2.5.3.2 Addicted to substances

2.5.4 Hearing impairment of both ears with hearing threshold higher than 40 decibels at 500 - 2000 Hz. and speech discrimination score less than 70 percent, which indicates sensorineural hearing loss that would hinder the study and practice of dentistry.

2.5.5 Vision disability, with medical examination deeming that such condition will be an obstacle to study and practice of courses in dentistry, specifically with vision correction with eyeglasses and the visual acuity of the good eye is lower than 6/12 or 20/40.

2.5.6 Severe color blindness or severe color vision defect with Farnsworth D-15 hue color blindness test resulting in 10 or more crossing lines (according to the guidelines on color vision examination by the Royal College of Ophthalmologists of Thailand) that would hinder study and practice of dentistry.

2.5.7 Other diseases or disabilities with medical examination deeming that such condition will be an obstacle to study and practice of courses in dentistry.

Note: The selection committee will consider all health problems and the decision will be final.

5. Application Process and Requirements

Applicants must enter their admission information online via the website <https://entry.wu.ac.th>. Follow the steps outlined using the information of the following required documents:

- 1) A completed application form. Attach a set of photos (1inch size, not older than 6 months)
- 2) A copy of transcript
- 3) A copy of ID card / passport
- 4) A copy of house registration (Thai residents only)
- 5) Printed receipt for non-refundable application fee of 1,500 baht.
- 6) Portfolio (English), 1 set with the following details:
 - (1) Portfolio or resume in English (academic achievement, extracurricular activities, awards, etc.)
 - (2) Activity information on morality and ethics; nurturing and promoting arts, culture and society
 - (3) Academic and special abilities
 - (4) English essay on "My goal as a dental student", not more than 2 pages of A4 paper (handwritten only)
- 7) Copy of qualification certificate High school or equivalent
- 8) English language test results as specified in item 2.3

NOTE:

Additional fee for successful applicants

- Confirmation of enrollment fee 400,400 (foreigner 450,000) baht

(once register in the program, this fee will transfer to the tuition fee for the first semester of 2021)

The university will not refund fees under any circumstances

- University dormitory reservation fee 2,700 baht
- Property damage insurance 5,000 baht

(refunded after graduation if no university's property damage during the cause of study)

6.Tuition fee **

The course fees for the Doctor of Dental Surgery (International Program) are as follows:

6.1 For Thai students: 400,400 baht per semester (four hundred thousand and four hundred baht)

6.2 For foreign students: 450,000 baht per semester (four hundred and fifty thousand baht only)

7. Other conditions for registered applicants

- 1) If Walailak University later finds that the application and required documents do not meet the University's requirements, the student's registration for study will be voided and **in no case will a refund be issued.**
- 2) Upon receiving acceptance, the student will be required to make a non-refundable 400,400 THB payment for the enrollment confirmation fee. Once the student registers in the program, this fee will transfer to the tuition fee for the first semester of 2021.
- 3) If the student is currently enrolled in a Walailak University program, the student must cancel his/her current enrollment prior to accepting the offer from this program. Violation of this regulation will result in the immediate cancellation of the applicant's admission in both programs.

8. Payment method

After filling the application form online, please print the application fee payment slip and make a payment deposit at the service counters or at the commercial banks anywhere in Thailand. Please do not to include the payment receipt in the submitted documents.

9. If there are any problems or issues regarding this announcement, the Walailak University's President is the one who make the final decision.

***Please be informed that the Doctor of Dental Surgery program (International Program) was approved by the Walailak University Council per meeting No. 3/2017 on the July 15, 2017 and accredited by the Thai Dental Council per meeting No. 9/2019 on the November 14, 2019.**

**** Scholarships**

The university offers two types of scholarships for international college of dentistry students:

1. Outstanding scholarship: This is a 100% tuition fee waiver throughout the course provided to students with excellent first-year academic results (GPAX of 3.5 or more) and no subjects with a letter grade F or U. The total number of outstanding scholarship students must not exceed 10 percent of the number of first-year students in each academic year.

2. Good Scholarship: Students with academic results at the end of semester 1 in the first academic year with a grade point average (GPA) of 3.25 and above and no subjects with a grade level of F or U will receive a 25% tuition fee waiver in the following semester. If students have academic results with a grade point average of 3.25 or more in every semester throughout the

course and no subjects with a letter grade F or U will receive a 25% tuition fee waiver for each subsequent semester. (Details as announced by Walailak University Subject: Scholarships for Applicants of the International College of Dentistry dated August 14, 2020)
